When I was a child, my father's home was heated by a wood-burning stove. My younger brother and I never much liked the work that was involved—in wintertime, there was always firewood to either cut, chop, load, unload, or stack! Now, however, I tend to look back on that time with a good bit of nostalgia. I linger on memories of the crackling fire, the aroma of burning wood in the air, or the sight of smoke flowing out the chimney.

For as long as people have been people, we have gathered around the

fire to tell stories, share memories, sing songs, or simply tend to the everyday tasks of our life together. Since time immemorial, fire has been a life-giving force that has brought us together in communities of care and support.
